DO YOU HAVE AN ARREST RECORD?

HAVE YOU EVER WONDERED IF YOU CAN HAVE YOUR RECORD SEALED OR EXPUNGED?

Arrest records can keep you from gainful employment, renting a home, make you unable to obtain certification or special licenses, and create many other problems.

The opportunity to keep an arrest record from public view is not to be missed.

That is why the Broward State Attorney's Office is offering this **Sealing and Expungement Program**. If you were charged with a crime in Broward County and the case did not result in a conviction, you may be eligible to have <u>a single arrest record</u> expunged. If you were charged with a crime in Broward County and you received an adjudication withheld, that case may be eligible to be sealed.

Only cases that occurred in Broward County in state court will be reviewed.

The first step to getting a record **sealed or expunged** is to apply for a **Certificate of Eligibility** from the Florida Department of Law Enforcement (FDLE). Visit the **Broward State Attorney's Office** at any of our locations and fill out a one-page questionnaire. We will help answer your questions about this process **at no cost to you** and determine if you qualify. If you qualify, our staff will prepare the FDLE Application for Certification of Eligibility for you and help you gather the documents that must be submitted. Please note that when you submit the completed application, the Florida Department of Law Enforcement **requires a \$75 processing fee**.
